Graveside services for Grace May Adams, 89, who died in Wheatland April 21, were held Tuesday in the Wheatland Cemetery at 3 p.m. with Rev. Delbert Dick officiating.

Adams was born Dec. 5, 1895 in Iowa where she spent her childhood years. She was the daughter of William and Annie Johnson.

In 1915 she moved with her parents to Wyoming where they homesteaded six miles west of Dwyer on Fish Creek. She and Claude Adams were married April 10, 1919. They lived with their 10 children on their ranch near Cottonwood Creek.

She was a member of the Rebekah Lodge, Laramie Peak Rock Hounds, Cottonwood Country Club and the Dwyer Homemakers.
