Services for Harold E. Allison, 68, were held Tuesday, July 28, at 10 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, Wyo. with Andy Gudahl, minister officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Allison died Thursday, July 23, at his home near Wheatland from an apparent heart attack.

He was born February 9, 1930 in Sheridan, Mo. He is the son of Ralph George and Hazel Inez (Herndon) Allison. They lived in Missouri until the early 1940's, when they moved to Wheatland. They resided on the LD Ranch, and then moved to Mule Shoe Ranch in the Wheatland area. He finished his education at the Wheatland schools.

He was married to Phyllis A. Twiford on September 12, 1948 in Wheatland. He was trained in the electronic field, first working as an electronic technician for Coast to Coast in Wheatland. The family then moved to California where he worked as an electronic inspector for Northrup Aviation for three years. In 1959 they moved back to Wheatland, and operated his father's ranch 13 miles south of Wheatland. He was engaged in ranching and farming for eight years, and then in 1965 he entered the real estate business. At the time of his death he was owner and operator of Allison Realty Company. He also owned and operated the Brahma Bar in Wheatland, with George Good, in the early 1960's. He was a member of the Chugwater Masonic Lodge and the Wheatland Moose Lodge. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, gardening and playing card games of gin, cribbage and bridge.

He is survived by his wife, Phyllis, of Wheatland; three children, Steve Allison of Littleton, Colo., Donnie Allison of Wheatland, and Donna Marcotte of Casper, Wyo.; one sister, Mary Allison Finkbiner of Wheatland, one brother, Eldon Allison of Wheatland; four grandchildren; and one great-granddaughter.

He was preceded in death by his father on November 29, 1964 and mother on August 22, 1997; one sister, Clara Allison Miller; and one brother, Darrell Dean Allison.

Serving as pallbearers were Bill Vines, Keith Anderson, John Suntych, George Good, Walt Taylor and Norm Erickson.
