

ALLISON, DR. JAMES GARNETT
September 12, 1902-May 16, 1978

Funeral services will be held Thursday, May 18, 1978, at 10:30 a.m. for one of Wheatland's most beloved and respected citizens, Dr. James G. Allison. Father Sid Hoadley will conduct the service at the United Church of Christ. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. The body will lie in state all day Wednesday afternoon and evening.

Dr. Allison passed away Tuesday, May 16, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 75. He was born in Greenview, Illinois September 12, 1902. After graduating from the University of Colorado Medical School, he served his internship at St. Louis General Hospital.

He came to Wheatland in 1933 to become associated with the late Dr. Fred Phifer. Upon Dr. Phifer's death, Dr. Allison took over the medical practice and the Wheatland General Hospital. He and Fay Ash were married in Wheatland in 1956.

He continued operating the hospital until he closed it and opened his clinic in 1965. Dr. Allison was indeed dedicated to his profession, having served the Wheatland community in that capacity for the last 45 years.

He was affiliated with the Masonic Lodge AF&AM #16 of Wheatland, BPOE in Laramie and various medical societies.

He is survived by his wife Fay; his son John David at home and a sister, Erma Osborne of Boulder, Colorado. He was preceded in death by a daughter, Garnette in 1966 and two brothers, Harry and Howard.

Serving as pallbearers will be Harold Rumsey, Bob Straw, Dr. William Wilson, Howard Fish, Bill Jones, and H.E. Hashberger. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements. A memorial has been established to the Platte County Memorial Hospital.
