

ALLOWAY, HOWARD B.

January 6, 1904-February 15, 1948

Howard B. Alloway, 44, died at his ranch home 42 miles northwest of Wheatland Sunday, February 15, following a heart attack. He had been ill for the past several weeks but not confined to his home.

Born in Bonesteel, S.D., January 6, 1904, he had been a resident of Platte and Albany counties for the past 12 years, coming here from Columbus, Nebr.

The deceased is survived by his wife, Ona; three children, Virginia, Warren and Ronald, all at home; his mother, Mrs. Alda Alloway of Ft. Collins, Colo.; two brothers, Everett Alloway of Ft. Collins and Gene Alloway of Alameda, Calif.; and one sister, Mrs. Herbert Morehouse of Ft. Collins.
