Services for Flora Lucinda Anderson, 77, who died Sept. 18, 1982, at Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne, were held Wed., Sept. 22 at 10:30 a.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Rev. Delbert Dick officiating.

She was born in Council Bluffs, Iowa, Sept. 22, 1904, the daughter of Roy and Minnie DeFrees Vinson. She was reared in Iowa and married Albert H. Anderson, Dec. 16, 1920, in Council Bluffs.

The couple farmed in Nebraska until after World War II when they moved with their family to the Wheatland area where they farmed. In 1965 they moved to Casper where they lived until they both moved to Eventide Manor in Cheyenne. Mr. Anderson died there in April of this year.

Survivors include three sons, Walter Anderson of Casper, Tom Anderson of Worland and David Anderson of Cheyenne; one daughter, Gladys Bowdish of Orin Junction; two brothers, Willard Vinson of Casper, John Vinson of Iowa; one sister, Margaret Hall of Council Bluffs; 16 grandchildren; 40 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.

Besides her husband, Albert, she was preceded in death by three brothers and a sister.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial has been established to the Platte County Senior Citizens Center.
