

ANDERSON, ROY DEWEY  
November 18, 1898-July 28, 1966

Funeral services for Roy Dewey Anderson, 67, were held Monday at 2:00 p.m. from the Methodist church with the Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery with Robert Blevins, Eldo Larson, Morris Kershner, Marlin Marshall, Glen Stellflug and Willard Baker serving as pallbearers.

Mr. Anderson, who made his home with his sister, Mrs. Joseph Weber, succumbed at the Weld County Memorial Hospital in Greeley, Colo. on July 28, 1966 following an extended illness. Born on Nov. 18, 1898 in Bladen, Nebr., he was a retired farmer, coming here from Bladen March 20, 1930. He was a member of the Antelope Gap Grange.
