Services for Eva Patricia Apodaca, 64, who died in Wheatland Feb. 18, 1989, were held in St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Guernsey at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, Feb. 21, 1989, with Father Bernard Bianco officiating.

Born Feb. 14, 1925, in Uva, she was the daughter of Felix and Librada (Morales) Gonzales. She was reared in Uva, attending grade school there, then graduated from Wheatland High School in 1943.

She went to work at the Wheatland Hospital and in 1946 married Alfred Apodaca in Wheatland. They moved to Sunrise, where they remained until 1967 when they moved to Guernsey. They lived there until the time of her death.
