

ARNOLD, MARY SAURBAUGH
1843-1924

Mrs. Mary Saurbaugh Arnold, pioneer of this section of Wyoming since 1889, and a leader among Wheatland women for many years, passed away Saturday at the home of her son, S.E. Arnold, at the age of 81 years, 2 months and 23 days.

She was born in Zanesville, Ohio, and was wedded to Silas Arnold, who died three years afterward, leaving one son, S.E. Arnold who was with her at the last. Together with S.E. Arnold, she came to LaGrange in 1889 living on a homestead for nine years and then coming to Wheatland.

The funeral was held Monday from the Congregational church, and she was laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery. Rev. Paxton read an appropriate tribute to her life and activities in this community which the Times will print next week.
