

AXFORD, ALFRED
1853-February 20, 1921

Mr. Alfred Axford, a well known farmer in this vicinity, passed away at his home Sunday afternoon, Feb. 20th. He had been under medical treatment for the past fifteen years, during which time he had consulted seven different physicians, among them being some noted specialists, who aided much in prolonging his life.

Mr. Axford was 67 years, 7 months and 9 days old at the time of his death. He gave much of his time in service to his Master and the studying of His word. He was a kind and devoted husband and father.
