Prominent Young Farmer Meets Death
From An Unusual Accident
Is Caught Between Hay Raek and Fence
Receiving Injuries Which Caused Death

L.L. Baker, a young farmer living about four miles from town, was caught between a board fence and a hay rake when the team standing started to run, crushing the upper part of his body so seriously that medical aid was useless.

Immediately following the accident, Baker was rushed to the Wheatland hospital, where he died last night.

Mr. Baker was twenty-two years of age and is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. W.A. Baker, four brothers and two sisters. Funeral services will be held in the Christian Church Tuesday.
