

PHYLLIS BAKER PASSES

The sympathy of the entire community goes out to Mr. and Mrs. Marlin Baker, of Wheatland, in the death of their little daughter, Phyllis Mae, which occurred on May 19th, following an illness of more than five weeks during which she suffered intensely. Phyllis was born on May 10th, 1921, in the Wheatland General Hospital, in which institution her mother was a nurse prior to her marriage to Mr. Baker.
