Ralph Baker, 76, of 409 10th St., Wheatland succumbed Sunday, June 29, 1975 at Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Rev. Delbert Dick and Rev. Elliott Graves presided over the funeral services held Wednesday, July 2, 1975 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.
