

BAKER, WILLIAM WARNER
May 15, 1895-November 8, 1918

William Warner Baker was born at Forsythe, Mo., May 15, 1895, coming to Wheatland in 1905 where he has since made his home. He united with the Christian church in 1908. He enlisted in the United States Navy May 28, leaving on June 20 for training at San Diego, Calif., and died Nov. 8 at that place of a short illness of Spanish influenza. He leaves to mourn his death a mother, a father, five sisters and four brothers, Mr. and Mrs. Robert A. Baker, Mr. and Mrs. J.L. Bookout, ?? David, Misses Beulah and Esther, and Robert and Ernest of Wheatland, Mrs. James M. ? of ??, and John Raymond who is now in the service in the Philippine Islands.
