

BALDIZON, PETER  
?-December 20, 1930

Pete Baldizon, 11 year old son of Mr. And Mrs. Abe Baldizon, living about six miles northeast of Wheatland, was fatally injured Friday afternoon when he was struck on the highway while on his way home from school. The truck was being driven by H.H. Eckes, who states that the boy started across the road directly in the path of the car, and that he did not have space in which to bring the truck to a stop before it struck the lad. The boy was struck by the bumper on the car and thrown for a considerable distance, sustaining a broken back and fractured skull. Mr. Eckes immediately brought the injured boy to Wheatland for medical aid, but his injuries proved fatal and he died shortly after reaching town. Mr. Eckes is held blameless in the accident but nevertheless is deeply grieved over the sad termination of the incident.

Funeral services for the boy were held at the Catholic church on Monday, with burial in the Wheatland Cemetery. The burial services was conducted by the Watson Mortuary.
