

Edna Pearl Barnes Succumbs Jan. 25

Mrs. Edna Pearl Barnes succumbed Saturday, January 25, 1975, at the Wheatland Nursing Home after an extended illness. She was 87 years old.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, January 28, at the Schrader Chapel. Rev. Elliott Graves presided. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery. Frank Rumsey, Bryce Orr, Steven Barnes, Charles Barnes, Kenneth Barnes II, and Irvan Ramsey served as pallbearers.
