

BARNES, JESSE RAY
1879-December 22, 1945

Jesse Ray Barnes passed away at his home just east of Wheatland Saturday, December 22, at the age of 66 years, death coming after a brief illness.

Born at Larwill, In., he came to Wheatland over thirty years ago, and while living here, was active in the life of the community. At one time he was rural mail carrier, and in recent years, had been employed at Wheatland Hardware. He was affiliated with the Methodist church.

Besides his wife, survivors include one son Kenneth of Wheatland who was recently discharged from the armed forces; one daughter, Mrs. Oscar Carlson of Trinidad, Colo.; two grandsons and two granddaughters.

Last rites were conducted at the Methodist church at 2 p.m. with the Rev. Maxwell officiating. Pallbearers were James Clark, James Chaplin, Tom Bouchard, John Rutz, Bart Bellis, and Tom Wilkinson. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with Schraders Funeral home in charge of arrangements.
