

BATEMAN, CHARLES A.

1864-December 7, 1945

Services were held at the Christian church last Monday for Charles A. Bateman, 81, retired veterinarian, whose death occurred at his home Friday, December 7, after an illness of several months. Pallbearers were Roy Purcell, Roger Mills, Sam Isabell, Clarence Grey, Charles Rietz, and Willis Hauk. The Rev. J.E. McElroy officiated.

The deceased was born in Des Moines, Ia., but had lived in Wyoming since 1927. He was affiliated with the Christian church of Wheatland where he had been a deacon for the past eighteen years.
