

**Frieda Mae Bauer**

Funeral services for Frieda Mae Bauer, 68, were held Friday, November 16, 1990 at 2:00 p.m. at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, Wyoming with Reverend Doctor James S. Vuocolo officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Frieda Bauer died suddenly on Tuesday, November 13, 1990 at her home in Wheatland.

She was born March 10, 1922 at Longmont, Colorado, the daughter of Jacob and Elizabeth (Ott) Wilhelm. In 1928 she moved with her parents to Wheatland, where she was reared and educated.

In 1940 she was married to George Bauer Sr. in Wheatland. They then moved to Buffalo, Wyoming where they remained until 1941, then moving to Gering, Nebraska. In 1945 they returned to Wheatland and moved in 1950 to Lingle, Wyoming. In 1953 they returned to Wheatland, where she remained a resident until the time of her death. She was a member of the United Church of Christ.

She is survived by three sons, George Bauer Jr, Kenneth Bauer, and Richard Bauer all of Wheatland; one daughter, Sally Bauer of Windsor, Colorado; two brothers, Victor Wilhelm and Edward Wilhelm both of Wheatland; three sisters, Elsie Margheim and Irene Spangler both of Wheatland and Emma Wetzel of Ukiah, California; six grandchildren; and one great grandchild.

She was preceded in death by her parents; five brothers; and two sisters.
