

Robert Everett Bealey

Funeral services for Robert Everett Bealey, 75, will be held Thursday, November 4, 1999, at 3 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Rev. Les Ludlam of the United Methodist Church officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mr. Bealey died Monday, November 1, 1999, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Robert was born March
