

BECK, CHARLES CLARK
December 10, 1869-January 27, 1950

Charles Clark Beck was born in Gallipolis, Ohio, December 10, 1868, and passed away at Wheatland, Wyoming, January 27, 1950, at the age of 81 years, 1 month and 17 days.

He was a member of the Order of Patrons of Husbandry and was the Treasurer of the Rock Lake Grange from 1916 to 1922 and remained in good standing until his death.

Three sisters and four brothers preceded him in death. To mourn his memory are Homer Clement and James Clement, nephews of Wheatland, Wyoming, Mrs. Sarah Spoons of Hamburg, Iowa, several nieces and nephews whose addresses are unknown.

Mr. Beck has been a resident of Plattè County, Wyoming since 1904, has been a good friend and neighbor to all who knew him.

The funeral services were held at 2:00 p.m. Monday afternoon at the Schrader Chapel, with Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Pallbearers were Charles Randall, A.A. Logan, Merle Logan, K.V. Howe, Jake Axford and Fred Ryff. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
