E.A. Belcher died at his home last Friday evening following a severe attack of heart trouble. He had been a sufferer for some time, though he was able to be about most of the time, at no time was his condition considered dangerous until Friday afternoon when he had the severe attack.

Deceased is 63 years of age. He is survived by his mother who resides at Superior, Neb.; two brothers, one residing in California and F.L. Belcher of this city; six children, three sons and three daughters.
