

BELCHER, EDWARD L.
June 22, 1888-March 12, 1965

Edward L. Belcher, a resident of Wheatland from 1912 to 1958 succumbed in the Cheyenne Memorial hospital March 12, 1965 after a short illness. Mr. Belcher was born in Cheyenne on June 22, 1888. Mr. Belcher was a butcher for many years in Wheatland for many years and served as a city employee at the cemetery before his retirement.

He was married to Eunice Louise Belcher in Denver, Colo. in 1912. Mrs. Belcher preceded him in death on July 20, 1954 and a granddaughter, Irene Daly on January 9, 1965.
