

BELCHER, EUNICE LOUISE BELCHER

December 5, 1892-July 20, 1954

A resident of Wheatland for sixty years, Mrs. Eunice Belcher, died Tuesday, July 20 at Iverson Memorial hospital in Laramie, following a lengthy illness. She was 61 years of age.

Survivors, in addition to her husband, Edward L. Belcher of Wheatland, are five daughters, Mrs. Florence Daly, Wheatland, Mrs. Frances Kline, Scottsbluff, Mrs. Nellie Kinnamon, Slater, Mrs. Hazel Dewey, Newcastle, and Miss Edna Belcher, Wheatland.
