

BELLIS, CAROLISLE WALKER

June 23, 1858-March 2, 1947

Carolisle Walker Bellis, 88, was born at Bean Lake, Missouri, on June 23, 1858, and died at the Wheatland hospital March 2 following an extended illness. He had been a resident of Platte county since 1919, having lived in Grant City, Missouri prior to moving to this country. He had made his home for over a year with his son, Ben, in Lingle, but had recently been brought to the hospital here. He was affiliated with the Christian church.

Survivors include three sons, W.B. Bellis of Wheatland, H.B. Bellis of Lingle, and Fred Bellis of Santa Maria, California; ten grandchildren and six great grandchildren; also one brother, A.B. Bellis of Omaha, Nebr. His wife, Mollie, one daughter and one son preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at the Christian church with the Rev. Charles F. Thomas officiating, assisted by J.E. McElroy. Pallbearers were James Clark, Claude Dawson, M.A. Thrasher, C.E. Artist, N.F. Hester and W.I. Sutherland. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
