

BENNETT, CLARENCE
May 17, 1888-August 18, 1968

Funeral services for Clarence Bennett, 204 12th St., who passed away Sunday, Aug. 18 at the Platte Memorial Hospital after a short illness, were held on Wednesday, Aug. 21, at 2:00 p.m. from the Schrader Chapel.
