

Virgil LeRoy Bennett

Funeral services for Virgil LeRoy Bennett, 47, will be held today (Wednesday, Aug. 31, 1994) at 2 p.m., at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.
