

BERG, JOHN CHARLES

July 9, 1870-1927

Funeral services for J.C. Berg, resident of Wheatland and Platte county for fourteen years, who died Friday morning, was held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 at the Methodist church with Rev. H.E. Shepherd officiating. The Watson Mortuary was in charge of funeral arrangements. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.

John Charles Berg, son of John and Latisia, was born in Iowa July 9, 1870. The family moved to Easton, Kan., a few years later where John grew to young manhood. Twenty-eight years ago, Mr. Berg journeyed westward and settled for a short time in the North Platte valley. From there he moved to Sunrise, but not until he had been united in marriage to Miss Augusta Neuman at Gering, Nebraska, on October 28, 1903. In 1913, Mr. and Mrs. Berg moved to Wheatland where he has since been engaged in agricultural pursuits. To this union were born two children, one dying in infancy and a daughter, Carelene, age 4, Agnes, age 13, and Ralph, now married, were adopted by the Berg family. He leaves to mourn his death a wife, Mrs. Augusta Berg, a daughter, Carelene, adopted son and daughter, Agnes and Ralph, a father, John Berg of Easton, Kan., three sisters, Katie Putman, Oklahoma City, Sarah Fitch and Margaret Berg of Easton, Kan., and brothers, J.W.
