

Raymond Edward 'Dutch' Berg

May 17, 1926 – January 10, 2012

Funeral services for Raymond Edward "Dutch" Berg, 85, were held at 1:00 P.M. Friday, January 13, 2012 at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland, Wyoming with Pastor Skip Perry officiating. Inurnment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Dutch Berg died Tuesday, January 10, 2012 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Dutch was born May 17, 1926 in Mitchell, Nebraska the son Eugene John and Pearl Edith (Thomas) Berg. He was raised and educated in Mitchell, and graduated from the Mitchell High School. He served in the United States Army during World War II. Following his discharge he returned to Nebraska, and lived in Crawford. He worked as a butcher for his uncle. He was married to Geraldine Jean "Jeri" Moss on July 22, 1947 in Chadron, Nebraska. They moved to Wheatland in 1952, where he owned and operated Dutch's Sunshine Market and the Gamble Store. He retired in 1986 following the fire that burnt the Gamble Store down.

He was a member of the International Order of Odd Fellows, Lions Club, Jaycees, Masonic Lodge, Wheatland Golf Club, Wheatland Country Club, United Methodist Church, the Mitchell and Wheatland Volunteer Fire Departments, and the Chamber

of Commerce.

He served on the board and as the President of Wheatland Golf Club at various times.

He is survived by his wife, Jeri, of Wheatland; children, Terry (Juanita) Berg of Lander, Wyoming, Phyllis (Herb) Johnson of Casa, Wyoming, David Berg of Wheatland, Dan (Tammy) Berg of Wheatland, and Tom (Tracy) Berg of Cheyenne, Wyoming; eleven grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister; and three brothers.
