

BERRY, ADA MAE WALKER
January 4, 1884-January 26, 1951

Mrs. Ada Mae Berry, 67, formerly of Guernsey and a resident of Denver for 10 years, died in the St. Anthony's hospital in Denver last Friday. Services were held in Wheatland Thursday (today) at 2 in the Congregational church with Rev. W. James Hoare officiating and Schrader's in charge of arrangements. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Berry's two sons, Maj. Frank Berry and Naval Lt. Fred W. Berry, both stationed in Japan, arrived in Wheatland today for the funeral.
