

Joseph Philip Bieber, four-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Bieber who reside a mile north of the fairgrounds, died here Sunday of spinal meningitis after a illness of a few days. The day of his death, his two-year old sister had taken ill with the disease, and at this time is said to be showing improvement.

The funeral of the little boy held Tuesday morning, was private, interment being made in the local cemetery by the Watson Mortuary.

While no new cases are reported at this time, it is well for parents to be on guard against a possible outbreak, making it a point to watch for any symptoms of the disease, such as vomiting, chills, fever or headache, which may develop. While children are known to be the most susceptible to the disease, which is very often fatal, adults are not immune. The safe thing to do at an early hour is to call medical aid.

Two deaths from meningitis occurred at Rock Springs this week and five mild cases of smallpox in that city are reported in press dispatches.

It is also understood that one or two cases were fatal in Cheyenne.
