Bernice A. Bird died Tuesday, April 10, 1979, at Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne at the age of 72. Funeral services were held Thursday, April 12, 1979, at the All Saints Episcopal Church with Father Sidney Hoadley officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Serving as pallbearers were Dale Hansen, Mark Good, Lewis Bird, J.R. Good, Phillip Bird, and John Bird. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements. A memorial has been established to the All Saints Episcopal Church for a light.
