

BLACHLY, CAROLINE K. STAUFFER

March 2, 1836-1928

Mrs. Caroline K. Blachly died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Nettie Pitcher, Sunday morning after a long illness. Funeral services were held from the Watson Mortuary Chapel, Tuesday afternoon at 2:30, with Rev. H.E. Shepherd preaching the funeral oration. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with Watson Mortuary in charge.

Caroline K. Stauffer, daughter of Abraham and Rebecca Stauffer, was born in Huntington county, Pa., March 2nd, 1836, being 92 years of age on her last birthday. She was married July 13th, 1851 in Valpariso, Ind. to Eben Blachly. Of this union, there were three children born, all of whom have passed away with the exception of one daughter, Mrs. Nettie Pitcher, with whom she has made her home since the death of her husband about 19 years ago. Her husband practiced medicine in South Dakota and Iowa. She became a christian in early womanhood which she followed constantly to the end. She was of a cheerful christian disposition and was a close companion of her daughter, Mrs. Pitcher, for many years. She was at one time a member of the Order of the Eastern Star.
