

BLACK, CYRUS MEREDITH
June 17, 1905-October 28, 1974

Cyrus Meredith Black of Wheatland, Wyoming, passed away on October 28, 1974 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Cy was born June 17, 1905 in the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma. He was the son of the late E. Black and Louis Morris. He was united in marriage to Grethel V. Mills on July 13, 1935 in Douglas, Wyoming. Cy and Grethel homesteaded at Esterbrook, Wyoming. They moved to Wheatland in 1940. He was a retired farmer and dairyman. He was a pioneer resident of the State of Wyoming. Mr. Black was a member of the Memorial Baptist Church of Wheatland.
