

BLANKENSHIP, MATA HALL
September 23, 1870-January 26, 1913

The passing of Mrs. J. Blankenship removed from the North Laramie community an exemplary character and from the home, a devoted and loving wife and mother.

Mr. Blankenship has been a sufferer for a long time and was brought to Wheatland last week and a serious operation was performed Wednesday. The patient rallied from the effects of the operation and was thought out of danger from that affliction, when on Sunday morning she was stricken with heart failure and eight hours later died from that disease.

Funeral services conducted by Rev. Paxton of the Congregational church in Wheatland Tuesday, interment being in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mata C., daughter of Ne (unreadable) and Martha Hall, was born near Bethany church, Isodell (?) county North Carolina, Sept. 23, 1870, and died January 26, 1913 at Wheatland, Wyoming. In about the year 1902, she came to Wyoming to make her home. About four years later she was married to J. Blankenship. In her demise, she leaves a husband and six year old son, an aged father and step-mother, one sister, one brother, one half brother and sister, besides a host of friends and relatives to mourn her untimely loss. In early life she profess her faith in a person Savior and united with the Presbyterian church near her home.
