

Services conducted Friday, June 9 for Wiley Lee Blevins

Last rites for Wiley Lee Blevins who succumbed suddenly at the Goshen County Memorial hospital on June 6, were conducted at the Schrader Chapel today (Friday) at 11 a. m. with Rev. Kenneth Gordon in charge of the services. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with Morris Kershner, Eldo Larson, Glen Weber, John Thal-kin, Cecil Miller and Vern Bomgardner as pallbearers.

The deceased homesteaded here in 1916, and had made his home 22 miles east of Wheatland, coming here from Missouri, where he was born on November 20, 1889 to John Wesley and Martha Carter Blevins. He was a member of the Antelope Gap Grange and the Presbyterian church.
