

BLISS, EDWARD JACOB

1869-May 10, 1946

Edward Jacob Bliss, 74, was found dead in his home six and one half miles south of Chugwater, Sunday, May 19, by Charles and Clifford Gartin. Ted S. Schrader, county coroner announced that an autopsy was performed, and it was found that he had died from heart disease. It is estimated that he died about May 10. He had been a resident of that community for the past nineteen years.

He is survived by his wife, Effie of Scranton, Penn.; two daughters, Mrs. Ethel Gibbs and Mrs. Clarence Coursen of Scranton, Penn.; two brothers, Frank Bliss, Little Bear, Wyo. and William Bliss of Portland, Ore.; three sisters, Mrs. Burton Brow of Cheyenne, Mrs. Joe Blackburn, Portland, Ore. and Mrs. Anna Mason of California.

Funeral services will be held today (Thursday) at the Schrader Funeral home with Rev. W.C. Keith officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
