

BLISS, J.W.  
May 3, 1863-1924

J.W. Bliss, well known ranch of the district Southeast of Chugwater, died Thursday, Sept. 4, after a long illness.

Mr. Bliss had been a resident of that district for many years, having developed a ranch 10 miles out of Chugwater near the Snow ranch. He was a native of Garrettsville, Ohio, where he was born on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1863. He later moved to Nebr., where he married in 1884 to Elizabeth Filzer. To this union six children were born as follows: Neil, who died in childhood, Mrs. Elmer Hix of Douglas; Mrs. Lorenzo Gregory of Hollywood, Calif.; and Messrs Percy, Jay and Don Bliss all of whom live at Chugwater.

The funeral was held at the Wheatland Masonic hall, Chugwater lodge No. 23, A.F. & A.M. taking complete charge. John Olson of Chugwater, Worshipful Master of the Chugwater lodge was in charge, the Rev. J.B. Milstead of Chugwater acted as chaplain. The burial took place in the Wheatland cemetery.
