

Vernon G. Blodgett

Funeral services for Vernon G. Blodgett, 84, will be held Monday, Jan. 10, 1994, at 2 p.m., at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Andy Gudahl, Minister, officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Blodgett died Thursday, Jan. 6, 1994 at the Sunset Manor Nursing Home in Brush, Colo.
