

BOCKING, LOUIS HENRY
February 14, 1874-December 21, 1958

Louis Henry Bocking, brother of Mrs. Emma E. Buechner, passed away December 21, at the age of 84, at Evanston, Wyo. He was born in Tulton, Mo. February 14, 1874, the son of Frederick and Minnie Judtson Bocking, and had lived in Wheatland for four years.

He was an assayer by occupation, and was employed for 25 years by the American Smelting and Refining Co., at Perth Amboy, N.J. He was a life member of B.P.O. Elks, Bisby, Ariz., and a past Exalted Ruler of that lodge.

He is survived by one brother, Charles of Bellevue, Wash., one sister, Mrs. Emma E. Buechner, and one niece, Mrs. B.A. Bowen, both of Wheatland. His wife preceded him in death a number of years ago.
