

# George Bohl, Jr.

July 26, 1913 – September 23, 2004

Funeral services for George Bohl, Jr., 91, were held 2 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 28 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland with the Reverend Lincoln Winter officiating. Internment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Bohl died Thursday, Sept. 23 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

He was born July 26, 1913 in Delta, Colo., the son of George and Catharina Elizabeth (Beitnitz) Bohl Sr. He was reared and educated in Delta and Lovell, Wyo. The family moved to Wheatland in December 1929. He farmed with his parents on the Wheatland Farm.

He was married to Elizabeth Viola Jessen on December 25, 1935 in Wheatland. They farmed four miles southwest of Wheatland until they retired to Wheatland in the 1970s. In his retirement years he worked for Drube Machine Shop and the Platte County Fair Board. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church. He enjoyed fishing, tinkering on farm machinery, restoring old tractors, gardening, his roses, and he had designed his own fishing pole holder.

He is survived by his children and their spouses, James A. and Kay Bohl and George A. and Sally Bohl III, all of Wheatland, Paul M. and Peggy Bohl of Boise, Idaho, and Katherine E. and John Klyop of Crystal Lake, Ill.; three
