

BOHL, KATHERINE ELIZABETH BEITNIZ  
February 14, 1888-April 23, 1964

Last rites for Katherine Elizabeth Bohl were held at the Schrader Chapel Saturday, April 25, at 3:00 p.m. with Rev. Elmer A. Reuscher officiating, and interment in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Bohl, who was born in Russia, Feb. 14, 1888 to Christopher and Margaret Beitniz, succumbed in the Platte County Memorial Hospital April 23, 1964, after an extended illness. Prior to moving to the Wheatland area in 1923, the Bohls resided in Lovell, Wyo.

The deceased had devoted her entire life to raising her family of eleven children, and her love of flowers was shared with neighbors and friends.
