Services for Marilynne P. Bohl, 63, will be held Saturday, January 16, 1993 at 12:00 Noon at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Bohl died Sunday, January 10, 1993, at the Iverson Memorial Hospital in Laramie, Wyoming.

She was born February 8, 1929 in Wheatland, the daughter of Amel and Karen (Olsen) Nelson. She was reared and educated in Wheatland, graduating from Wheatland High School.

She received her Nursing Degree from the Denver Presbyterian School of Nursing. She worked as a registered nurse in Wheatland before she eloped with Kenneth R. Bohl to Yuma, Arizona.

Her husband was in the Navy so she went with him to Long Beach, California, and Seattle, Washington; while there she worked on the bases as a nurse.

After her husband's discharge, they returned to Wheatland and later lived in Cheyenne before moving to Laramie in 1959. She worked for 45 years as a nurse in several locations. She attended the First Christian Church and was a member of the Wyoming Nursing Association.

Mrs. Bohl is survived by her children Kenneth C. Bohl of Loveland, Colorado and Karen "Carri" Bohl of Laramie, Wyoming.

She was preceded in death by her husband.
