

BOHMONT, JOHN EDWARD
January 1898-November 22, 1980

Services for John E. Bohmont, 82, who died Nov. 22, 1980, were held today (Wednesday) at the United Methodist Church with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

John was born Jan. 7, 1898, the son of John Henry and Alice Helen Bohmont, in Martell, Neb. He was educated in the Martell schools then attended business college in Lincoln.

On March 20, 1918 he married Mary Armann who was a neighbor. Following their marriage the couple moved to Wheatland where they settled on a farm owned by Mary's family. They made their living in farming and ranching until 1930, although John continued to operate the farm until 1946.

Around 1930 John accepted a position with the federal government and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. He worked in that organization in several capacities until his retirement in 1963.

Upon his retirement the couple continued to live in Wheatland. He was a member of the United Methodist Church and the Odd Fellows Lodge.

Survivors include his widow, Mary; a son, Dale of Reno, Nev.; a daughter, Mildred Emerson of Green River; four brothers; five sisters; four grandchildren; and two great-grandsons. He was preceded in death by a brother and two sisters.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial has been established in John's name to the United Methodist Church Organ Fund.
