

BOLICH, JACKSON HAROLD
September 9, 1893-October 8, 1977

Services for Jackson Harold Bolich, 84, Guernsey, Tuesday, October 11, 1977, in the Schrader-Prell Chapel with the Rev. Mary Bahmer of the Guernsey Community Church officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mr. Bolich passed away Saturday, October 8, 1977 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

He was born September 9, 1893 in Winner, S.D. He moved to Long Pine, Neb. during his childhood and while there met Ollia Metcalf, whom he married May 14, 1917 in Ainsworth, Neb. After their marriage, they moved to McCook, Neb. where he was employed by the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad. In 1923, they moved to Sunrise where he was employed by the Chicago-Wyoming Railroad. After retirement in 1961, they moved to Guernsey where he lived until his death.

He is survived by his wife, two sons, E.H. "Red" Bolich of Wheatland and Jackson D. "Punk" Bolich of Guernsey; four daughters, Helen Hughes of Long Beach, Calif., Maxine Bennett of Fairbanks, Alaska, Beatrice Vannelli of Hartville, and Betty Peterson of Wheatland; nine grandchildren and eight great grandchildren. One brother, Cecil Bolich, preceded him in death.
