

BOLTE, MAY LONG  
September 9, 1876-April 9, 1926

Mrs. Edward Bolte died at 11 p.m. Friday at her home in Wheatland, after an illness of three years and three months, at the age of 49 years and seven months.

She was born in Pike County, Mo. September 9, 1876, her maiden name having been May Long. When eight years old, she moved with her parents to Mt. Rose, Kansas. The family lived there two years then went to Quincy, Ill., where she resided until wedded on January 29, 1893 to Thomas McMullen.

She then moved with her family to Burlington, Ia., where they lived until they came to Wyoming in March 1916. During the following winter she was married to Edward Bolte.

She leaves four children as follows: Mabel Mae McCarty of Portland, Ore., Eva Belle Meads of Pekin, Ill., Ellen Jane Gilgren of Dalton, Nebr., and William McMullen of Dalton, Nebr. She is also survived by an adopted child, James Bolte, by her husband, and by nine grandchildren. All the children came for the funeral.

Two brothers are believed to be still living, Harley Estes of Peoria, Ill., and Arthur Estes, whose whereabouts is unknown.

She was laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery yesterday afternoon, the funeral having been held from the Lutheran church, with Rev. H. Hoyer in charge.
