

BOOKOUT, JOSEPH LUTHER
January 19, 1888-January 11, 1955

Joseph Luther Bookout, 66, local rancher and resident of the area since 1905, died at a hospital here Tuesday following a short illness. He was born in Forsyth, Mo. January 19, 1888 and made his home in that state before coming to Wyoming.
