

BORRALL, MARY F. JOHNSON
December 12, 1852-April 30, 1924

Mary F. Johnson was born in Kentucky December 12, 1852, and died in her home in Wheatland, Wyo. April 30, 1924, after an illness of three years.

At the age of seven, she moved with her parents to Iowa where she grew to womanhood. January 14, 1877, she was married to F.C. Borrall. To this union were born eight children, three of whom died when young. A son, Owen Borrall, died six years ago and rests in the Wheatland cemetery. Besides her husband, she leaves four daughters, of whom three, Mrs. C.A. Hightower, Mrs. G. H Kuehner, and Mrs. U.V. Combs, all of Wheatland, were at her bedside when she died, and Mrs. Alice Nanney of Seattle, Wash., who was unable, because of illness, to attend the funeral. Besides these, she leaves two sisters, Mrs. R.J. McLucas and Mrs. Willis Thompson, and a brother, John H. Johnson, of Greeley, three other brothers, W.P. Johnson of Milo, Iowa, J.A. Johnson of Wheatland and George Johnson of Casper, all of whom were present at the funeral, except the brother in Iowa. Besides these, she leaves a host of other relatives and friends to mourn.
