

BOUGHN, MARK DENNIS
September 18, 1938-December 3, 1945

Mark Dennis Boughn, seven-year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Mark Boughn, was instantly killed just west of the corner of 11th and Gilchrist in Wheatland at 12:50 Monday noon when struck by a car as he was returning to school.

Dennis was born in Wheatland September 18, 1938 and was in his second year of school when the tragedy occurred.

Besides his parents, he leaves a younger sister, Candace, his paternal grandmother, Mrs. M.S. Boughn of Walthill, Nebr., and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. H.A. Berry of Denver, Colo. His paternal grandfather, M.S. Boughn, preceded him in death by eight days.

Services were held for the child at 10:30 Wednesday morning in the Congregational church, the Rev. W.J. Hoare officiating, and Schraders were in charge of arrangements. Music was provided by Mrs. Weidner, Mrs. Noel Dugan, and Mrs. Betty Groesbeck of Cheyenne, and pallbearers were Fritz Drube, Dr. W.E. West, Denzil Blow and J.E. Foreman. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
