

BOUGUVIS, TOMIS CONSTANTINE

February 15, 1887-April 17, 1967

Long time Sunrise resident, Tomis Constantine Bouguvis, succumbed in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on April 17, 1967, where he had been confined since the last of December. Before his retirement, Mr. Bouguvis had been a miner for the C.F. & I. Corp. for thirty years and a resident of Sunrise since 1917. He was born in Greece Feb. 17, 1887, and was a member of the Ahepa Lodge No. 159 of Casper.

Surviving relatives include three cousins, John Krionderis of Hartville; George Krionderis of Topeka, Kans. and Nick Krionderis of Laurel, Md. Two brothers preceded him in death.

Last rites were conducted by Rev. Theodore Foster at the Schrader chapel on April 20, at 2:00 p.m. with interment in the Wheatland cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were Pete Douva, Vic Birleffi, John Chiamulon, Nick Lagos, Tom Costopoulos and O.K. Axford.
