

BOVEE, JAMES M.
March 3, 1860-April 10, 1938

James M. Bovee, former resident of Wheatland, died of a stroke at the Ivinson Memorial hospital in Laramie Sunday evening at the age of 78 years.

Born March 3, 1860 in Fairfield, Illinois, Mr. Bovee came to Wyoming in 1919. He became established first in Cheyenne and then moved to Wheatland where he lived until 1934. He has lived in Laramie the last four years.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Westley Johnson of Sandcreek and Mrs. Gretchen Galligar of San Francisco; a son, Glen, of Shawnee, Oklahoma, and five grandchildren. Mrs. Bovee died in Wheatland four years ago this month.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 in Laramie with the Rev. Claire C. Hoyt of the First Methodist church officiating. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
